Opportunities Include:

- Undergraduate scholarships (open to sophomores, juniors, or seniors)
- Graduate scholarships (graduate students, including medical students)
- A Fellowship (open to students with learning disabilities)
- Study Abroad Scholarships
- Partnered Scholarships
- Internship Endowment

Applying for a Scholarship:

- Read the Application and Directions
- Pay Attention to Application Deadlines (Due Dates)
- Meet the Eligibility Criteria (GPA, Income, Class Level, etc.)
- Schedule Time to Gather & Create Materials
 - Completing the application
 - Writing a personal statement or essay
 - Obtain letters of recommendation
 - Copy of transcripts
 - Financial verification of need

Tips from Successful Scholarship Applicants:

- Be detail-oriented
- Provide a positive perspective on "self" in personal statement or essay
- Emphasize community service and leadership experience
- Do not assume people know you or know about you
- Know the interest of the foundation or donor
- Make sure how you will use the funds match the expectations of the donor or foundation

Facts:

- A limited number of students apply
- Half of the applications are started, but never completed
 - Missed Deadline for Submission
 - Not have the letter of recommendation
- Half of the completed applications, are not comprehensive or have a poor perspective on "self"
